Vernon - Daniel Patrick Toye, age 63, passed away on Saturday, December 3, 2016 at his residence after a long illness. Born in Morristown to the late John and Gertrude (Magner) Toye, Daniel worked in Bayonne before moving to Sussex County. He had been a member of the Local 6 Carpenters Union, retiring when he was age 55. Daniel was also the co-owner of Toye's Recreaton, which has been a family owned and operated business for more than 50 years in Vernon.
