Eugene S. Drew, age 49, passed away peacefully at his residence on Monday, December 8, 2025. Born in Pompton Plains, Eugene grew up in West Milford and lived in Vernon for most of his life where he raised two children. He had been a self-employed diesel mechanic, owning and operating ESD Truck and Heavy Equipment since he was 19 years old. Eugene was very creative and was a self-taught artist. He enjoyed watching football and coached in his younger years while his son was playing. He also was a true motorcycle enthusiast that cherished riding his Harley, while finding freedom and peace in every mile. Eugene found his greatest joy at the racetrack, whether kicking up dust on dirt or carving lines on asphalt. His dedication and skill led him to win a Legends Car championship in 2019; an achievement he boasted about that stood as a testament to his love of the sport.
