Milford, PA - John P. Scott, age 76, passed away on Friday, May 21, 2010 at Overlook Hospital in Summit, NJ. Born in Wilkes Barre, PA to the late Earl and Anne (McNelis) Scott, he had been raised in Jersey City and resided in Rutherford before moving to Milford, PA in 2002. Mr. Scott had served in the United States Army and had graduated from Montclair State University. He had served as a New Jersey State Senator for six years, first elected in 1992. He retired in 1997 and had been working as a consultant on Republican political campaigns, including the successful Kameen for Judge campaign in 2003. Mr. Scott was a member of the Milford Bible Church in Milford, PA, the American Legion Post #139 in Milford, the Holland Society of New York, the Sons of the Revolution, and the New York and New England Genealogical Societies.
