Wantage -Kazimierz S. Marcinkowski, age 87, passed away on Sunday, November 10, 2013 at the Kindred Hospital at St. Clare's in Dover. Born in Golup, Poland on September 4, 1926, he attended high school and trade school in Grudziadz. During World War II, Kazimierz served with Polish Forces in the United Kingdom. In 1947, he was discharged from the Polish Army. In recognition of his service, he was decorated by British and Polish authorities. Kazimierz worked in the construction industry in London, England until he left for the USA. He arrived to Bloomfield, New Jersey on August 21, 1951 and continued his career as a carpenter. In 1952, Kazimierz joined Joseph Poniatowski Beneficial Association. He was also a member of the Polish Veteran SPK No. 35 in Newark. In 1959, Kazimierz married Aniela in Gdnask, Poland and they lived in Bloomfield before moving to Sussex County. He is survived by his wife, Aniela; his son, Lester Marcinkowski and his wife Sonia of Glenwood; his daughter, Dorothy Strand and her husband Steve of Maidens, Virginia; and his two grandchildren, Jennifer and Steven Marcinkowski.
