She received her Bachelor of Science in Education from Bowling Green State University and her Master of Arts from Ohio State University. She was a retired elementary teacher and reading specialist in the Columbus Public School System. Mrs. Perry devoted herself to giving young children a solid foundation in reading skills and life knowledge to set them on a path for success. Always placing the welfare of others before herself, Mrs. Perry lived a life of faith lovingly caring for and enjoying her family; sharing her vast knowledge of the Bible and living faith through her work with Emaus Walks; Women's Bible Study Fellowship; Vacation Bible School, Sunday School, and Circle programs at the Church of the Master; selecting books for her church library; and volunteering at a local hospital.

She was an active member of Delta Kappa Gamma Society for women educators, having held various officer positions. Mrs. Perry was a member of the International Reading Association, Greater Columbus Reading Council, National Council of Teachers of English, National Education Association, Ohio Education Association, Central Ohio Education Association, the Columbus Education Association., and Kappa Delta Pi Education Honorary. reader, she also enjoyed writing, sewing, music, travel, and ornithology. Small in stature but mighty in her ability to share her love and faith, Mrs. Perry was an inspiration to those fortunate enough to cross paths with her.

Besides her parents, she was predeceased by her husband, Paul J. Perry on December 6, 2003. She is survived by her daughter, Karen L.
