Many knew him as the “smooth operator,” since he believed he was “the best machine operator on the east side of the Mississippi.” Michael had a passion for motorcycles and being on his bike. Michael was an avid fisherman and was known for “ripping lips.” He also enjoyed “hitting bombs” on the softball field. Most recently, his latest obsession was his love for exploring the deep seas as the “captain” of the boat and traveling as far out in the ocean as he could go.
