All of the Sedlak family used to go to grandma Helen's house in Clifton. Then family functions at moms in Garfield and Sussex. I drove you and Steve and your friend John Chan in my rambler. The three of us were in each other's weddings. We all attended each other's children's weddings. We even flew across the country to attend my sons Ken's wedding. You were his godfather. You went to my daughter Michelle's house for a family celebration. I helped you buy your first house in Hackettstown. I was there when Danielle was born. Then visited you in your beautiful home & was proud when you became Chief financial officer in Florida. I remember enjoying a lovely walk with you as you smoked your cigar until you mentioned for me to stay away from the gutters because there were alligators there.

I visited you when you moved to North Carolina and started bagels on the hill. I loved your bagels!

I also shared the sad times with you. Was there when Donna passed away. You took great care of her and dad until he passed away.

When you moved to Sussex County we spent the most time

together. You were only five minutes away taking care of dad . I took you to oldies concerts, the farm & horse show, fireworks in Sparta, , celebrated New Year's Eve together, weddings, St Michaels banquet at the Venetian, birthdays etc.

You loved your Starbucks, your vitamins, jogging, going to the gym.. I was happy that you found love again with Robin. You were in your happy place in Atlantic City with your beautiful ocean view.
