Sussex - Michelle Bassani McKenney, age 48, peacefully passed away on Thursday, August 9, 2018 at Chilton Medical Center after a lengthy illness. Born in Dover, Michelle grew up in Sussex County, where she has lived all of her life. She was a 1988 graduate of High Point Regional High School and earned her Bachelor of Nursing degree from William Paterson University. She was dedicated to her nursing profession and began her career at St. Clare's Hospital in Sussex, where she continued to work per diem. She was a RN-BSN and had been employed by Chilton Medical Center in Pequannock. Growing up on a farm in Wantage, Michelle became very fond of all animals, but had a special love for all cats. She was a member of Psi Chi, International Honor Society of Psychology, International Association of Forensic Nursing, and the American Society of PeriAnesthesia Nurses.
