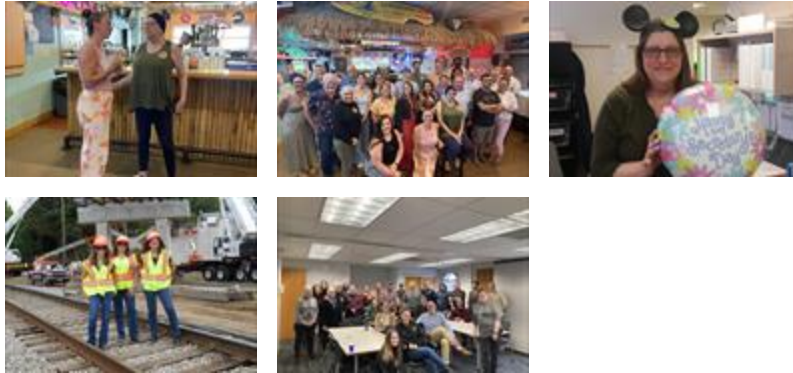
Michelle will be deeply missed, but she will never be forgotten.
