WANTAGE - Paul Charles Convery, Jr. 85, passed away on Monday, December 29, 2025, in Wantage, New Jersey. Paul was the son of the late Paul Charles Convery, Sr. and Rose (Miller) Convery, and was born on September 11, 1940 in Butler, PA.

Paul proudly served in the United States Navy from 1958 to 1961 on the aircraft carrier, USS Bon Homme Richard (CV-31). Following his military service, he built a long and dedicated career as a car hauler and truck driver. Known for his ability to fix anything, whether it needed it or not, Paul was always ready to lend a hand. 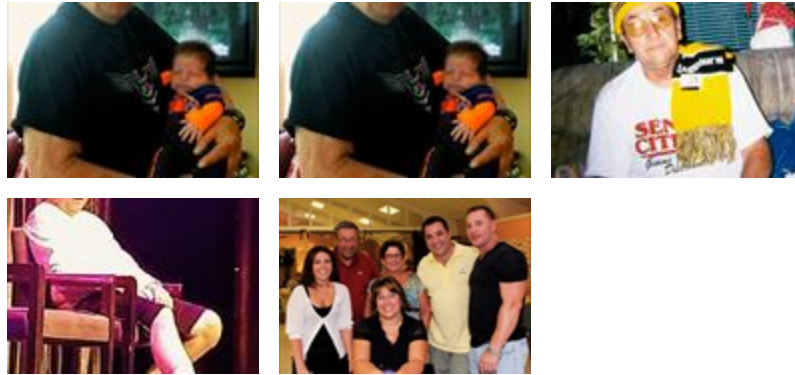
