Wantage - Peter R. Bina, age 90 passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, March 3, 2025.

Born in Sao Paulo, Brazil on May 4, 1934 to the late John and Kathleen Bina, Peter grew up in São Paulo before coming to the United States in 1961. He lived in Minnesota, California and New York, before eventually settling in Wantage, New Jersey, where he spent the remainder of his life. Peter had been employed as a Pharmaceutical Executive for American Cyanamid/Pfizer in Wayne before his retirement.

Besides his parents, he was predeceased by his brother, John Bina. Peter is survived by his daughters, Heather Bina and her husband Levi and Sarah Bina.
