June 30, 1946 - January 25, 2016

Richard E. "Richie" Steinbacher, 69, died on Monday, January 25, 2016 at Englewood Community Hospital in Englewood, FL while fighting pneumonia. Born in Englewood, NJ on June 30, 1946, he was predeceased by his parents, Raymond and Katherine "Jean" Steinbacher. After growing up in Wayne, NJ, Mr. Steinbacher started a career as a builder with Sherman Brothers. He moved to Vernon, NJ in 1973, where as a builder for Country Homes, he oversaw construction of hundreds of homes. In 1992, he moved to Milford, Pa where over the next 13 years, he built numerous homes as a private contractor and a member of the Pike County Builders Association. An avid golfer, he was also a member of the Port Jervis Country Club for many years. He moved to Florida in 2005 where in his semi-retirement, he continued to work part time as a real estate agent and golf as much as he could.
