May 6, 1958 - January 14, 2021

Wantage - Robert "Tee" Tribuzio, age 62, passed away on Thursday, January 14, 2021 at his residence. Born in Brooklyn, New York, Tee has lived in the Lake Neepaulin section of Wantage for most of his life. He was a member of St. Monica R.C. Church in Sussex. Tee was a licensed hairdresser in the county. Most recently, Tee has been actively involved at Blue Arrow Farm in Pine Island, New York. His spirit as the official "Mayor" of Blue Arrow Farm will live on forever. He had a heart of gold and the voice of an angel. He was well known for taking the stage to sing a variety of songs ranging from his beautiful rendition of Ave Maria to rock and roll classics, and with each song he managed to always wow the audience.

Tee was predeceased by his devoted mother, Marie Tribuzio on September 24, 2019. He is survived by his brother, Steven Tribuzio and his wife Linda; his nephew, Branden Tribuzio; his niece, Alyshia Tribuzio; and many close friends. Memorial graveside services and interment at Clove Cemetery will be held at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, June 8, 2021. 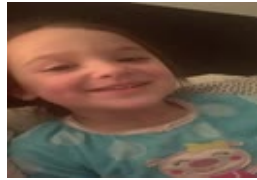
