Teddy Lee Cosgrove, a devoted husband, father, and man of faith, passed peacefully into the arms of Jesus on Saturday, July 26, 2025, at the age of 79. Born on April 26, 1946, in Mount Tabor, New Jersey, Teddy was the cherished son of George and Frances Cosgrove.

Teddy was predeceased by his late wife of 37 years, Rosalyn Cosgrove as well as brothers Richard, George, and Glenn Cosgrove.
