West Milford - Verlin R. King, Sr., age 77, passed away on Sunday, January 23, 2011 at Chilton Memorial Hospital in Pequannock. Born in Charlotte, North Carolina on November 10, 1933 to the late Theron and Gladys King, he had lived in Garfield before moving to Franklin in 1997.
